BIRD WATCHER'S FIELD KIT

The BIRD WATCHER FIELD KIT comes with everything you need for bird watching in the field. In this complete kit you get a pair of 5 x 30 power binoculars with 2.5" lens shades, a lightweight tripod that can be tabletop or handheld, plus three different bird callers (Reed, Whistle and Warbler) for attracting every kind of bird. From Loons to Hawks, Geese to Ducks, and just about every backyard song bird.

USING THE BIRD WATCHER FIELD KIT

- The Bird Watcher Field Kit gives you the perfect tools to start bird watching, or "birding" as it is commonly known.
- Start out by reading your Bird Watcher Pop-Up Field Guide to learn more about bird basics, how to find them, and which birds are typically found in your area.
- Head outdoors and find a good location to set up your equipment.

FIELD BINOCS:

Adjusting field of view: Customize the fit of your binocs to your face by holding them up and looking through the lenses. Do you see two images or one? If you see two, rotate the halves back and forth around the center pivot until you see one image.

Adjusting focus: While looking through the lenses, are the images clear or blurry? Depending on how close or far away an object is, you may need to adjust the focus. Use the gray knob in the middle of your Field Binocs to adjust the focus by rotating it left or right until the edges of the image are clear and sharp.

ADJUSTABLE TRIPOD:

- Your Tripod can be used two ways – on the ground with the legs extended, or with the legs folded and snapped together for handheld viewing.
- Insert your Field Binocs into the top of the Tripod until they click into place. Swivel the top of the Tripod to your desired position.

WATER WARBLER:

Fill the bottom chamber of the bird's body with water using the opening on the mouthpiece. Be sure not to add too much water or it will pour out of the secondary opening. Blow gently through the mouthpiece to make a warbling bird sound.

WHISTLE CALLER:

Blow into the caller and move your hand back and forth over the hole on the end to vary the sound.

REED CALLER:

This caller has a reed inside of it, which flutters when you blow through the mouthpiece. Blow from your stomach without letting your cheeks puff out. A duck quack call comes from blowing sharply into the caller. Start by blowing single notes, then string them together to create the basic duck call.

Observe as many birds as you can and use your Bird Watcher Pop-Up Field Guide to help identify them. If you've spotted a match, "tick" it off on your guide.

BIRD WATCHER KIT SAFETY AND CARE

- Be respectful of nature. Never harm birds in any way or try to scare them.
- Occasionally wipe the lenses of the Field Binocs with a soft cloth or lens tissue to remove dust, dirt, or fingerprints. If the lens is extra dirty, use a lens cleaning fluid. Be sure to apply the fluid to the cloth, not the lens, as this may cause the lenses to get foggy.
- Occasionally wipe the tripod and bird callers with a damp cloth to keep them clean and looking new.
- Use under normal and safe play conditions only.
- When not in use, store items in a clean, dry area and do not leave them exposed to the elements.
- Occasionally, after use, inspect the items before putting them away.
- Remember, if you follow the instructions and keep the Bird Watcher Field Kit clean, it will provide you with tons of fun.
