Bug Collector Flashlight Instructions

Have you ever seen a bug or insect and wished you knew more about it? Like where it went at night? What do bugs do in the dark anyway? Do they sleep like us or walk around all night? Well, now is your chance to have your questions answered and to better understand the bugs and insects you see all around you. With your new Backyard Safari Bug Collector Flashlight, not only can you find bugs in the dark, but you can carry them along!

1 Bug Collector Flashlight with removable bug habitat

INSTALLING/CHANGING THE BATTERIES:

The Bug Collector Flashlight requires 3 C batteries. Alkaline batteries are recommended. Never use rechargeable batteries.

You will need a small screwdriver to remove the cover and access the battery chamber.

- 1.) Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover located on the base of the Bug Collector Flashlight. Remove the cover completely.
- 2.) Next, place the new batteries in the compartment as indicated by the Polarity symbols.
- 3.) Replace the cover and hold it in place while you tighten the screw.

USING THE BUG COLLECTOR FLASHLIGHT:

Carefully remove your new Bug Collector Flashlight from its package and read all the instructions thoroughly before use.

Once free from the packaging, turn on the Bug Collector Flashlight by pressing the button on the top of the handle. Well, pretty cool, huh? THE EYES LIGHT UP!! Okay, is it dark out? Perfect, go outside and set up your Bug Collector Flashlight. Now, wait and watch! The light from your Bug Collector Flashlight will attract all kinds of awesome bugs! Once the bugs begin to come to the Bug Collector Flashlight, take your Backyard Safari Bug Vacuum and gently capture the bugs. After a careful examination, you can either let them go or place them into the removable Bug Habitat portion of your Bug Collector Flashlight! The Bug Habitat can be pulled to remove by pressing the button on the handle. To transfer the bugs is simple! On the back of the Bug Habitat there is an area that has a circle just the right size for the Backyard Safari Bug Vacuum capture core. Remove the lid, place your Bug vacuum to the hole and gently release the bugs into the Bug Habitat. And replace the lid! Don't forget to replace the lid or all your hard work will be for nothing! Now, when you get ready to remove the Habitat, just release the button on the inside of the handle

and push down and the Bug Habitat will come right out! When you are all finished, don't forget to turn the Bug Collector Flashlight off and store it in a safe place.

Okay, there is one more VERY IMPORTANT THING for us to talk about. The idea is for you to be able to learn about insect and bugs WITHOUT touching them. All living creatures may bite or sting if they feel trapped or in danger. Nature gives all living creatures the ability to protect themselves from harm. They need these abilities to survive and fend off predators. So, as tempted as you might be, DON'T TOUCH! Remember, the best explorers leave things just as they found them. The goal is always to learn and never to harm. And if you do keep the bugs you find, remember you are now responsible for them and must meet all their needs. Food, water, safety! There is one last surprise your new Backyard Safari Bug Collector Flashlight has in store for you.....if you turn it on and shine it on the wall, you will be able to see the light just as one of the bugs you found would see it!! How cool is that!! Now you have bug vision!

CARING FOR THE BUG COLLECTOR FLASHLIGHT:

Keep the Bug Collector Flashlight and removable habitat clean and dry. If it does get wet, wipe it dry immediately.

Use under normal, and safe play conditions only. When not in use, store the Bug Collector Flashlight in a clean, dry area and do not leave it exposed to the elements.

Watch for any cracks or damage.

Occasionally after use, wipe the Bug Collector Flashlight off with a damp cloth before putting it away. Don't forget the habitat; you need to keep that clean also!

Remember, if you follow the instructions, keep the Bug Collector Flashlight clean and remember not to leave it outside, it will provide you with tons of fun.

CAUTION

Do not leave your Bug Collector Flashlight outside or exposed to the elements.

The Bug Collector Flashlight is intended for bugs and insects only. Do not shine it directly into the eyes of another person or pet.

When cleaning the Bug Collector Flashlight, **USE ONLY WATER AND NEVER HOUSEHOLD PRODUCTS**, not even window cleaner. The same is true for the Habitat area....clean with water only!

Lastly, remember, while insects and bugs may be interesting and fun, it doesn't mean you should pick them up or handle them in any way. Some insects and bugs may even bite or sting if they feel frightened or trapped. You're an explorer, so be smart and careful in the way you treat all living things in nature. The idea is to learn and explore but, it is your responsibility to use the Bug Collector Flashlight properly. A good explorer always respects nature. Also, if you keep the bugs you find, it is your job to take proper care of them. Which means giving them food, water, and a safe, clean place to live.

BATTERY CAUTION

Only adults should replace batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.

Any batteries installed in your Bug Collector Flashlight are for demonstration purposes only and we make no warranty as to the battery life. Replace the batteries when the Bug Collector Flashlight stops operating properly.

Batteries can leak chemicals and harm electronic parts, so remove them if you do not plan to use your Bug Collector Flashlight for several weeks.

- Use only fresh batteries of required size and recommended type.
- Never use rechargeable batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be charged.
- Be sure the batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
