

Butterfly Habitat Instructions

Have you ever watched a butterfly go by and wondered what its colors look like up close? Are their wings soft or maybe fuzzy? How about when something buzzes by too quickly for you to really see it? Well, now you have a fighting chance to catch up and take an exciting look!

USING THE BUTTERFLY HABITAT

Carefully remove your new Butterfly Habitat from its package and read all the instructions thoroughly before use. Once free from the packaging, the Butterfly Habitat should spring up and take shape. If this does not happen, it may be that the Velcro strap on the Habitat needs to be released. Once the Habitat is open, examine the fabric and netting for any tears or rips. Also check the flap at the top of the Habitat to make sure it opens and closes properly. Okay? Great, let's get started having fun! Now, the Butterfly Habitat is best used with the Backyard Safari Critter Catcher. The Critter Catcher will help you SAFELY capture the butterflies. So, grab your Critter Catcher and let's go outside! But first, did you READ ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS, including what NOT to keep in your new Butterfly Habitat? The idea here is to have fun exploring and getting the chance to look at butterflies and other flying insects you might not normally be able to see up close. So, what happens when you catch something? Well, that's the fun part! First, hold onto the strap while you insert the closed Critter Catcher net in the top opening of the Habitat and then press the release button. The butterfly will then be released into the Habitat. Remember, you have to hold the strap or the habitat will collapse when you push down on the top. Once the butterfly or other flying insect is completely free of the Critter Catcher, simply pull the empty net back through the opening. Take a minute to make sure the tension lid has closed properly or all your hard work will be for nothing! Remember, you don't want to hurt the insects. Butterflies, as well as other insects have fragile wings that may be damaged if you capture them in the Creature Catcher incorrectly or place them in the Habitat too roughly. So, if the butterfly seems stuck or to be struggling, carefully help it from the net as it may be a bit frightened. That's it! Sounds easy, right? Here is another cool thing about your new Butterfly Habitat, it is perfect for raising caterpillars! And it has a handle

so you can easily and safely transport your new friends, just grab it by the Velcro strap and off you go! One more IMPORTANT THING, don't forget to take some time to learn what your butterflies and other flying insects like to eat. REMEMBER, you are their only source of food and water so, make sure they have plenty to eat and drink. Your butterflies are counting on you. Please don't take your new responsibilities lightly.

Good luck and have fun but, remember to be responsible with your new Butterfly Habitat. You're an explorer, so be smart and careful in the way you treat all living things in nature.

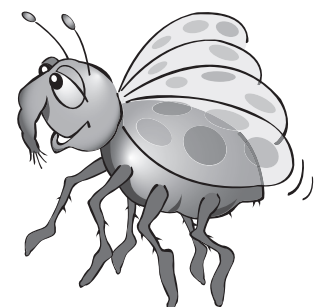
CARING FOR THE BUTTERFLY HABITAT

Keep the Butterfly Habitat clean and dry. If it does get wet, wipe it dry immediately.

Use under normal, and safe play conditions only.

When not in use, store the Butterfly Habitat in a clean, dry area and do not leave it exposed to the elements. Storing the empty Butterfly Habitat is easy, just push down until the Habitat comes together and then secure it with the Velcro strap.

Occasionally wipe the Butterfly Habitat off with a damp cloth and inspect the netting. If the Habitat needs a more thorough cleaning, simply rinse it out with a garden hose and let it dry completely. Don't forget to first place your butterflies and other flying critters in a safe place before cleaning the Habitat. Remember, if you follow the instructions and keep the Butterfly Habitat clean, it will provide you with tons of fun.



⚠ CAUTION

Do not leave your Butterfly Habitat outside or exposed to the elements.

The Butterfly Habitat is not a cage. Do not use it to house people or your other household pets, not even for fun.

Do not try to store or transport other small object with the Butterfly Habitat. This toy is intended only to be use for butterflies and other flying insects. Trying to store or carry other objects in it may tear the netting or fabric.

DO NOT USE THE BUTTERFLY HABITAT to collect HORNETS, BEES or WASPS!

DO NOT USE THE BUTTERFLY HABITAT to house BIRDS, SQUIRRELS or ANY OTHER SMALL ANIMALS!

DO NOT overpopulate the Habitat.

Once the Habitat is populated, make sure to keep it in a quiet and safe area away from household pets and small children who may become overly curious. It is important that the Habitat be placed some where it can not be bumped into or knocked over. That kind of sudden shock may harm or even kill the creatures inside.

Butterflies are fragile, treat them with great care.

Be careful of sharp branches and twigs that may rip or tear the netting.

Do not use the Butterfly Habitat if the net is torn or ripped

Lastly, remember you are using the Butterfly Habitat to explore and learn about living creatures in nature. The Butterfly Habitat is not to be used to harm or injure any living thing. If you do keep the butterflies or other flying insects you catch, make sure to provide them with plenty of food and water and always keep the Habitat in a safe place. Otherwise, look, learn and then let them go safely back where you found them.

Remember, it is your responsibility to use the Butterfly Habitat properly. Always respect nature.
