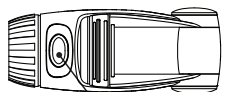


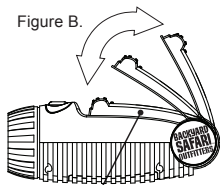

INSTRUCTIONS:

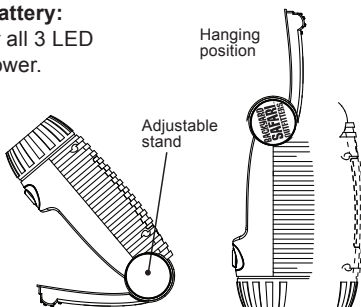
The 3 LED lights are controlled by a 3-position switch. (Figure A.) Slide the switch left for all 3 lights to illuminate using battery power. Slide the switch right to use hand crank power. Slide the switch to the middle position to turn off the Flashlight.

• **Using the Flashlight via the hand crank:** Open the crank from its storage position against the flashlight. Crank the flashlight in a back and forth movement. (Figure B.) Cranking it for 1 minute gives you over 30 minutes of light. Excess cranking will not hurt the unit.

• **Using the Flashlight with the battery:**

Slide the 3-position switch right for all 3 LED lights to illuminate using battery power.

NOTE: Keep switch in the off position when not in use.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

- Keep the Flashlight clean and dry. If any part of the Flashlight gets wet, wipe it dry immediately. Use and store indoors, in environments which maintain normal temperatures.
- Handle the Flashlight carefully and do not drop it.
- Occasionally wipe the Flashlight with a damp cloth to keep it clean and looking new. Do not allow water in or near the Flashlight as this may damage the device.

⚠ BATTERY CAUTION:

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

Only adults should replace batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury batteries.

Replace the batteries when the Flashlight stops operating properly or becomes dim. Batteries can leak chemicals & harm electronic parts, so remove them if you do not plan to use the Flashlight for several weeks.

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Never use rechargeable batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Be sure the batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the Flashlight.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

INSTALLING/CHANGING THE BATTERIES:

Your new Flashlight requires 2 x 'AA' batteries (INCLUDED). Use a Philips screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover and lift the cover. Install 2 x 'AA' batteries into the compartment, being careful to match the polarity as indicated (+ and -). Replace the cover over the compartment and tighten the screw.

COMPLIANCE WITH FCC REGULATIONS:
