DORA BUTTERFLY NET AND NURSERY Instructions

Have you ever watched a butterfly go by and wondered what it looked like up close? Are their wings as soft as they look? And what about all those beautiful colors? Well, now you have a chance to catch up and get a good look at these exciting and delicate creatures! So, let's go!

CONTAINS

- 1 Talking Dora Butterfly Net.
- 1 Expandable Butterfly Nursery.

USING THE DORA BUTTERFLY NET AND NURSERY:

Carefully remove your new Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery from the package and read all the instructions thoroughly before use. Once free from it's package, the Butterfly Nursery should spring up and take shape. If this does not happen, it may be that the Velcro strap on the Butterfly Nursery needs to be released. Once the Butterfly Nursery is opened, examine the netting and fabric for any tears or rips. Also, check the flap at the top of the Butterfly Nursery to make sure it opens and closes properly. Remember, the Butterfly Nursery is to be used with the Dora Butterfly Net. It will help you to SAFELY catch your butterflies....and gently place them in the Butterfly Nursery. Everything okay so far? GREAT! So, what are we waiting for, let's get started having fun!

Okay, so your outside and you see a beautiful butterfly and you want to get a closer look. Well, with your Dora Butterfly Net you can! Hold on, did you notice the button on the handle of your Butterfly Net? Well....press it and you will hear Dora talking to you and giving you encouragement! Now, that's cool! You check the net for any tears, right? GOOD! Now, carefully scoop up the butterfly into the net. Remember, butterflies are fast and fragile, so you must be quick and careful! You're an explorer now and the care of any animal is important! So watch out for those beautiful, but delicate butterfly wings. Now, when catching your butterflies, remember BE GENTLE! So, what happens when you catch one? First, hold onto the strap and insert the closed net into the opening at the top of the Butterfly Nursery and release the butterfly into it's new temporary home. Remember, you have to hold the strap or the Butterfly Nursery will collapse when you push down on the top. Once the butterfly is completely free, pull the empty net back through the opening. Now, take a minute to make sure the tension lid has closed properly or all your hard work will be for nothing! And most importantly, remember you don't want to hurt the butterflies. Their wings are VERY fragile and may be damaged if you collect them improperly or place them in the Butterfly Nursery to roughly. So,

if the butterfly seems stuck or to be struggling, gently help it from the net as it may be a bit frightened. Also, you will need to make sure to supply the butterflies with food and to keep the Nursery in a safe place. The goal here is to have fun exploring and getting the chance to enjoy butterflies, but you'll have to take care of them too! That's it! Sounds easy right! The Butterfly Nursery is perfect for watching butterflies. Don't forget though; only keep the butterflies you catch for a day or two. Butterflies need lots of room to fly around and be happy. Your new Butterfly Nursery is meant to be a temporary home. Besides, there's plenty more butterflies to catch with your Dora Butterfly Net and tons more fun to be had! One more cool thing about you Butterfly Nursery, it has a handle, so you can easily and safely transport your new friends, just grab it by the handle and off you go! Don't forget to take some time to learn about your new butterflies, you're their only source of protection. Make sure they have everything they need, they're counting on you, so please, don't take your new mission lightly! Be responsible with your new Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery. You're an explorer, so be smart and careful in the way you treat all living things in nature. So, that's it! It really is that easy. Good luck and have fun!

CARING FOR THE DORA BUTTERFLY NET AND NURSERY:

- Keep the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery clean and dry. Use under normal, and safe play conditions only.
- When not in use, store the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery in a clean, dry area and do not leave them exposed to the elements.
- Storing the empty Butterfly Nursery is easy, just push down until the Butterfly Nursery comes together and then secure it with the Velcro strap.
- Occasionally, wipe the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery off with a damp cloth and inspect all the netting and fabric. If the Butterfly Nursery needs a more thorough cleaning, simply wash it out with a garden hose and let it dry completely.
- When cleaning the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery, NEVER use household cleaning products. Use WATER ONLY.
- Remember, if you follow the instructions and keep the

Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery clean and take care of the butterflies inside, they will provide you with tons of fun and give you the chance to see some really beautiful butterflies up close!

CHANGING/INSTALLING THE BATTERIES:

The Dora Butterfly Net requires 2 AAA batteries. Alkaline batteries are recommended. Never use rechargeable batteries.

- 1.) Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover on the underside of the handle. Remove the cover completely.
- 2.) Now, place the new batteries in the compartment as indicated by the polarity symbols.
- 3.) Replace the cover and tighten the screw.

⚠ CAUTION

Do not leave your Dora Butterfly Net or Nursery directly exposed to the elements.

The Butterfly Nursery is not a cage. Do not use it to house people or pets or any other animal, not even for fun!

Do not try and store or transport other small objects in the Butterfly Nursery. This toy is intended for Butterflies ONLY. Trying to store or transport other objects may cause a tear in the netting or fabric.

DO NOT USE THE DORA BUTTERFLY NET OR NURSERY TO COLLECT HORNETS, BEES OR WASPS!

DO NOT USE THE BUTTERFLY NURSERY TO HOUSE SQUIRRELS, BIRDS OR ANY OTHER SMALL ANIMALS....EVER!

Do not use or point the Dora Butterfly Net at people or household animals. The Butterfly Net is not to be used to chase your pets or people around.

DO NOT OVER POPULATE THE BUTTERFLY NURSERY!

DO NOT USE THE DORA BUTTERFLY NET TO DISTURB BIRD'S NESTS OR THE HOME OF ANY ANIMAL.

Once the Butterfly Nursery is populated, make sure to keep it in a quiet, safe area away from pets and small children who may become overly curious. It is important that the Butterfly Nursery be placed somewhere it will not be bumped into or knocked over. That kind of sudden shock may harm or even kill the delicate creatures inside. Butterflies are fragile, treat them with great care!

Be careful of anything sharps, such as twigs or branches as they may cause a rip in the netting and or fabric of your Dora Butterfly Net or Nursery.

Do not use the Dora Butterfly Net or Nursery if the fabric or netting is torn.

Lastly, remember you are using the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery to explore and learn about living creatures in nature. The Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery is not to be used to harm or injure any living thing. Butterflies need lot's of room to fly, so only keep them in the Butterfly Nursery for a day or two. Remember, you can always get more and the idea is to watch and learn about these beautiful creatures. Look, learn and then let the Butterflies go back where you found them. Remember, it is your responsibility to use the Dora Butterfly Net and Nursery properly. Always respect nature!

⚠ BATTERY CAUTION

Only adults should replace batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them. Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may leak or explode. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited. Batteries can leak chemicals and harm electronic parts so, remove them if you do not plan to use your Dora Butterfly Net for several weeks. Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
