Saving money is easier than ever! Your new Counting Piggy Bank will count each coin you add to the bank so you will always know exactly how much money you have saved.

⚠ BATTERY CAUTION!

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

Only adults should replace batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury batteries.

Replace the batteries when the Piggy Bank stops operating properly or the display becomes dim (Note: Removing the batteries will reset the account balance to zero). Batteries can leak chemicals and harm electronic parts, so remove them if you do not plan to use your Piggy Bank for several weeks.

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Never use rechargeable batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Be sure the batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

1. Installing/changing the batteries.

Your new Counting Piggy Bank requires 2 x AA batteries. Remove the coin slot from the Bank carefully. Use a Phillips screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment and lift the cover. Install 2 x AA batteries into the compartment, being careful to match the polarity as indicated (+ and -). Replace the cover over the compartment and tighten the screw. Insert the coin slot firmly back into the Bank.

2. Deposit coins.

Insert a coin into the slot in the top of the Counting Piggy Bank. The amount deposited will be displayed on the screen.

- ⚡ **Press reset button on the coin slot module to clear the account balance or reset the Counting Piggy Bank. The account will be reset to zero and \$0.00 will be displayed on the screen.**
- ⚡ **Keep the Counting Piggy Bank clean and dry. If any part of the Bank gets wet, wipe it dry immediately. Use and store the bank indoors, in environments which maintain normal temperatures.**
- ⚡ **Handle the Bank carefully and do not drop it.**
- ⚡ **Occasionally wipe the Bank with a damp cloth to keep it clean and looking new. Do not allow water in or near the electronic slot, as this may damage the device.**
- ⚡ **Modifying or tampering with the Counting Piggy Bank's internal components can cause it to malfunction and will void any warranty.**

COMPLIANCE WITH FCC REGULATIONS
