

Electronic Vault

Instruction Sheet

Installing Batteries:

The Vault uses 3 x "AA" batteries (not included).

Suggest using good quality alkaline batteries.

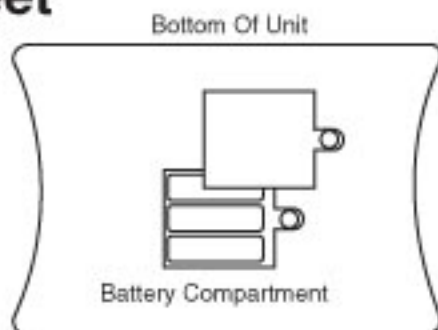
1. Use a Phillips screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover and lift the cover.
2. Put the batteries into the compartment using care to match polarity (+/-) as marked inside.
3. Replace the cover and tighten the screw.

CAUTION:

- Only adults should replace batteries.
- Replace the batteries when The Electronic Vault stops operating properly.
- Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.
- If you do not plan to use your Electronic Vault for several weeks, remove the batteries. Batteries can leak chemicals that can harm electronic parts.

To Operate:

1. The unit automatically turns on when the combination dial is turned to enter a combination.
2. Enter the preset 3-digit number code on the 25 number combination dial. **THE PRESET COMBINATION IS 0,0,0.**



- Turn the dial to the right, stopping when you reach the first code number number.
 - Turn the dial to the left, stopping when you reach the second code number.
 - Turn the dial back to the right, stopping when you reach the third code number.
3. When the correct 3-digit code is entered a (2 second) acceptance sound is played. When the wrong 3-digit code is entered a (4 second) alarm is played.
 4. Once the correct 3-digit code has been entered, turn the large spinning handle to open the Vault.
 5. The unit automatically turns after a decline alert is played or 10 seconds after a correct combination is entered.
 6. To lock the Electronic Vault, close the doors and turn the spinning handle fully counter-clockwise.

Resetting Combination:

1. Press the "reset code" button on the back of the left door.
2. Enter the new code using the dial. (Follow the same steps listed in the **TO OPERATE** section.)
3. Press the reset button to save the new code.
